



COVID-SAFE PLAN 2021

For this year's Wyndham City WERRIBEE MANSION RUN, we will ensure that the event is safe for all participants, volunteers, staff, spectators and the general community. The event will be undertaken in accordance with the Victoria State Government guidelines for community events – Tier 3 (events under 1000 participants)

Some of the changes to previous year's event are listed below. We will work with key stakeholders at all times to ensure the event is safe and compliant.

Therefore, the conditions below may change at any time.

LIMIT

- The field limit for this year's event will be 950.

PRE- EVENT

- If participants feel unwell, please stay at home.
- All participants are to be registered prior to the event (at this stage we will not be taking on the day registrations).
- Registration will be done online where participants will be asked to choose a preferred start time zone.
- Due to restricted numbers, we encourage spectators to not attend the event unless you are a parent/guardian or carer of a participant.
- All participants must complete the screening questions prior to arriving at the venue. These questions will be sent out with your E-ticket in the week leading into the event.

AT THE EVENT

- When not running/walking, masks must be worn.
- A wave start system will be in place to ensure participants can maintain physical distancing at all times.
- Physical Distancing of 1.5m apart will be adhered to at all times. Both on course and at the event site.

- Ground markings will be used to assist with Physical Distancing where lines or queues may occur.
- Spectators are asked not to attend the event. If you are a parent, guardian or carer and must attend you must complete the QR code check in on arrival.
- Participants are asked to arrive at the event at a set start time zone. If you arrive a little early, please assemble a suitable distance from the start line to avoid overcrowding.
- Additional cleaning will take place in areas such as bathrooms and at drink stations and other high contact point areas.
- Gloves and hand sanitizer will be used will be used at all aid stations.
- Volunteers/staff will be required to wear masks at all times.
- A race briefings will be conducted online for participants to read or watch pre-event.
- The Presentation Ceremony will not take place at the event, winners will be announced via email, social media and the event website.
- Signage will be used as constant reminders to all involved to adhere to the COVID guidelines.
- Hand sanitiser stations will be prominent and available for all staff, volunteers and participants to use.

POST EVENT

- All participants are asked to sanitise as soon after crossing the finish line.
- All participants are encouraged to leave the venue soon after they cross the finish line.

We will have both staff and volunteers at the event to ensure all the above measures are enforced. So please be kind to them as they will be trying to keep both yourself and everyone safe.
